In the last 12 months, you've challenged us to think strategically, develop creatively, and give significantly. **We are so lucky to have you!**



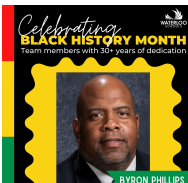
February Be Bold Award Winners
