

GRANTS

The WSF is proud to offer bi-monthly grant cycles for students and staff. Educators can apply for funding to bring innovative learning opportunities directly to the classroom, like an interactive floor for special education students.

Students receive money to bridge the financial gap for unique academic opportunities. In the past, students have used WSF dollars to attend conferences, academic competitions, create student-led programs within the district, and much, much more.

DISTRICT INITIATIVES

District initiatives are large-scale projects, prioritized by the Superintendent and the WCSD School Board, that have the potential to impact student learning district-wide. Our most recent initiative, Teach Waterloo, allows our support staff of diverse background to achieve their education degree from UNI while working for the Waterloo Schools free of cost. We committed up to \$300,000 for this program through the late Eleanor Ketchum's generosity.



Other initiatives of note include Camp Invention, Coaches Academy, Teacher License Reimbursement, and Twice Exceptional.



ANNUAL BREAKFAST

Every spring, the Waterloo Schools Foundation hosts our annual Sparking Academic Excellence Breakfast. This event recognizes the partnership of the Foundation with the Waterloo Schools, honors WSF funding recipients, and celebrates the successes of public education with our community.

Community members are invited to learn about all 19 WCSD schools in a sciencefair style session, and then gather at reception tables for a program. The WCSD Superintendent provides a state of the district address, and we often hear from an alumni keynote speaker.
